2. Forest of Dean Spring and Autumn Half Marathons

The three gentlemen from the Rotary Club came to discuss if the athletic club would like to be involved in the running of the two Half Marathon Events. Alan stated that we would be interested in general, but we do not have the experience to organise large scale events. We could definitely help with registration and marshalling duties and possibly set up in the days prior to the events and clearing of the field afterwards.
